

2016 KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Jefferson Keel, Lieutenant Governor of the Chickasaw Nation, is a retired U.S. Army officer with over 20 years of active duty service. His combat experience included three years service in Vietnam as an Infantryman, where he received the Bronze Star with "V" for valor, two purple hearts and numerous other awards and decorations for heroism. Lt. Governor Keel has always proven himself as an effective leader. He is a former Airborne Ranger, and served as an instructor in the elite US Army Rangers.



In addition to Lt. Governor Keel, the event will have American Indian veterans participating from the Pokagon Bode'wadmik Ogitchedaw of Michigan. One of the opening prayers will be provided by Head Veteran George Martin and traditional drumming will be provided by Bear River.
