

Internet for Low-Income Households

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) helps low-income households pay for internet service and connected devices. Eligible households may receive:

- Up to \$30/month discount on internet service.
- Up to \$75/month discount if the household is on qualifying Tribal lands.
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer (with a co-payment of more than \$10 but less than \$50).

You can see if you qualify and apply by visiting ACPBenefit.org.

Only one monthly service discount and one device discount is allowed per household. Not all participating internet service providers offer device discounts.
