COVID-19 Emergency Utility Subsidy Program

The Sault Tribe Housing Authority is accepting applications for Water/Sewer Utility Subsidy Program beginning October 5, 2020.

Applications are processed on a first come first serve basis and will continue until all funds are exhausted. Funds will be distributed directly to vendors providing water/sewer service.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Program Requirements:

- The applicant or his/her minor children shall be an enrolled member of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians.
- Applicant/household must reside in the Tribe's Seven County Service Area proof of residency is mandatory.
- Applicant/household must meet current NAHASDA income guidelines and provide proof of income for the entire household. See below chart for family size and total household gross income:

\$500.00 per household. Only served one time.

- Utility Assistance is provided by CARES Act funding.
- Water Shut off Notices are NOT required.
- Assistance payments are sent directly to water/sewer vendors.
