VACCINATION STATUS

The Health Division administered 303 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine last week. Since Dec. 17, 2020, the Health Division administered 5,361 doses.

UPDATE

A mega vaccination event for over 1,300 patients is scheduled in Sault March 3 and March 4 at Big Bear Arena. Mega vaccination events the week of March 15 and the week of April 5 are being planned and will be announced as soon as they are scheduled.

PRIORITIZATION CRITERIA

Waiting and scheduling lists are based on current prioritization criteria:

1. A. Health Division personnel.
1. B. Critical personnel of the Sault Tribe (non-Health Division).
1. C. Sault Tribe Elders (60 years and older)
2. A. Sault Tribe members aged 16 years old and older who are at a high risk for development of severe COVID-19 illness due to underlying medical conditions (such as cancer, obesity [BMI > 30], chronic kidney disease requiring dialysis, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, heart conditions, immunocompromised state from organ transplant, sickle cell disease, vascular disease, and type 2 diabetes) and/or experiencing homelessness. 2B. Essential workers with direct interaction with the public or in high-density work places.
2. B. Essential workers without direct interaction with the public.
3. Essential workers without direct interaction with the public.
4. Individuals 16 years old and older without high-risk conditions.
