A parcel of land located in the North ½ of the Southeast ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 29, Town 47 North, Range 1 East, Soo Township, Chippewa County, Michigan being more particularly described as follows:

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## U. S. DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY FY 2021 HOMEOWNER ASSISTANCE FUND

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a duly organized Indian Tribe under the Indian Reorganization Act of June 15, 1934 (P. L. 73-383, 48 Stat. 984); and

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians Housing Authority ("STHA"), is organized by Tribal Ordinance, pursuant to the authority of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Sault Tribe Housing Authority (STHA), is organized by Tribal Ordinance, Chapter 90 and formally designated by the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians Board of Directors as the Tribally Designated Housing Entity (TDHE) by Resolution No 98-66; and

WHEREAS, under section 3206 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the ARP) the Homeownership Assistance Fund (HAF) is established under the U. S. Department of Treasury (Treasury) and notes the Tribally Designated Housing Entity of an Indian Tribe as an eligible entity to apply for funding, funding authorized by this bill is available until September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the HAF was established to mitigate financial hardships associated with the coronavirus pandemic by providing funds to eligible entities for the purpose of preventing homeowner mortgage delinquencies, defaults, foreclosures, loss of utilities or home energy services, and displacements of homeowners experiencing financial hardship, after January 21, 2020, through qualified expenses related to mortgages and housing; and

WHEREAS, the Treasury requires the applicant TDHE to create a certified digital identity in the Treasury State, Local and Tribal Portal (SLT Portal) to submit the Treasury Notice of Funds Request, once approved the Financial Assistance Agreement must be submitted to the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, by June 30, 2021 the TDHE must submit to Treasury, a completed HAF plan or a date by which a HAF plan will be submitted; and

WHEREAS, the Sault Tribe Housing Authority Board of Commission authorized the Housing Director or designee, to create a certified digital identity in the Treasury State, Local and Tribal Portal (SLT Portal), to submit the Treasury Notice of Funds Request, and the Financial Assistance Agreement, as described above, and hereby requests concurrence from the Tribal Board of Directors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Sault Tribe Board of Directors hereby provides concurrence and authorization to the Sault Tribe Housing Authority Director, or its duly authorized representative, to complete the on-line submission, as noted above, to secure U.S. Treasury Homeowner Assistance funding.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Sault Tribe of Chippewa Indians Board of Directors hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson of the Tribe, to accept the FY 2021 Homeowner Assistance Funding and execute such documents and agreements as may be necessary to further this purpose.

WHEREAS, the issue is known collectively across Native communities as "Missing and Murdered Indigenous Persons", MMIP; and

WHEREAS, a community response plan that includes Victim Services, Media and Public Communication, Law Enforcement, and Community Outreach Partnership, will greatly enhance our preparation and response to missing persons reports; and

WHEREAS, the Missing and Murdered Indigenous Persons Coordinator, in the United States Attorney's Office, Western District, has worked with the Tribal Chairperson, the Executive Director, Representatives from Law Enforcement, Anishnaabek Community and Family Services, Advocacy Resource Center, Communications, Prosecutors Office, Culture and Language Department, Planning and Development, our partners at Uniting Three Fires Against Violence, and together have developed a Missing and Murdered Tribal Community Response Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby approves the Tribal Community Response Plan and intends for this plan to be continuously updated and reauthorized.

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## CHILD PROTECTION BACKGROUND CHECK INVESTIGATION PEER RECOVERY COACH EXCEPTION

WHEREAS, 25 USC 3201 requires the Tribe to conduct background checks of all employees and volunteers whose positions involve regular contact with or control over children; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors per Resolution 2018-293 adopted an updated version of the policy entitled "Child Protection Background Investigation for Team Members Having Regular Contact with or Control over Children" ("Policy"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors per Resolution 2018-293 further resolved that the Human Resources Department is directed to work with program directors, managers, and supervisors to review all existing job descriptions to ensure that they are in compliance with the revised Policy; and

WHEREAS, currently, with minimal exception, any position within Health Services shall require a Child Background Investigation under the Policy; and

WHEREAS, the position of Peer Recovery Coach is under the Health Services umbrella; and

WHEREAS, the Policy allows an avenue for Departments to have certain positions excluded from requiring a background investigation if the Department can ensure that employees in that position will have no unsupervised contact with children; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department has invoked the option to have the Peer Recovery position excluded from the Policy because the position has no contact or interaction with children and further, the Health Department can ensure that the Peer Recovery Coach position will have no unsupervised contact with children.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Sault Tribe Board of Directors hereby grants an exemption for the Peer Recovery Coach position from the Policy; thereby the Peer Recovery Coach position shall not require a background investigation under the Policy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Human Resource Department is directed to make any and all necessary changes to the Policy to exclude the Peer Recovery Coach position from requiring a background check under the Policy.
