Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians COVID-19 Vaccine Update Feb. 1, 2021

VACCINATION STATUS

By the end of the day on Friday, Jan. 30, the Sault Tribe Health Division administered 1,095 doses of COVID-19 vaccine for the week. Out of 1,095, only 21 doses were first doses. The rest of the inoculations were second doses (boosters).

Waiting and scheduling lists are based on current prioritization criteria:

1. A. Health Division personnel.
1. B. Critical personnel of the Sault Tribe (non-Health Division).
1. C. Sault Tribe Elders (60 years and older)
2. A. Sault Tribe members aged 18 years old and older who are at a high risk for development of severe COVID-19 illness due to underlying medical conditions (such as cancer, obesity [BMI > 30], chronic kidney disease requiring dialysis, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, heart conditions, immunocompromised state from organ transplant, sickle cell disease, vascular disease, and type 2 diabetes) and/or experiencing homelessness.
