What is the Sault Tribe Internship Program?

The Sault Tribe Internship Program is intended to be an exciting experience providing Sault Tribe member college students with an opportunity to learn more about the Sault Tribe and gain practical experience in their chosen field of study. Interns will work approximately four days per week at their assigned placement and approximately one day per week will be spent attending Leadership seminars and career development workshops. In addition, Interns will be divided into teams and will compete in challenges involving special projects; for example, designing and implementing a fundraising event. Interns will have the opportunity to interact with the Tribal Board of Directors, Executive Administrators and Program Directors.
