LIMITED WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY AND CONSENT TO WAIVER OF TRIBAL COURT JURISDICTION FOR

WHITE PINE LODGE ENTERPRISES LIQUOR LICENSE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors for the Sault Ste. Tribe of Chippewa Indians:

Section 1 FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS: The Board of Directors finds and determines that:

- 1.1 The tribe has purchased White Pine Lodge hotel and convenience store located in Christmas, MI, as a wholly owned governmental instrumentality of the tribe.
- 1.2 The purchase includes the transfer of a state liquor license from the seller to the tribe in the name of White Pine Lodge Enterprises
- 1.3 The state of Michigan is unable to transfer the liquor license to the tribe in the name of White Pine Lodge Enterprises absent a limited waiver of sovereign immunity from the tribe in favor of the state.
- 1.4 In order to facilitate the transfer of the liquor license the tribe pledges herein to not claim tribal immunity or exclusive Tribal Court jurisdiction with respect to any disputes or causes of action between the state and tribe that might arise from, or relate to, in any respect, the state liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises as limited below. All of the foregoing are referred to herein as the "Waiver and Consent Obligations."
- 1.5 It is in the Tribe's interest to resolve as stated herein.

Section 2 WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY; CONSENT TO JURISDICTION; GOVERNING LAW

2.1 The tribe hereby waives its sovereign immunity from suit in favor of the state of Michigan only should an action be commenced by the state in furtherance of its obligations to regulate the liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises. This waiver is not granted for any other state of Michigan liquor licenses the tribe may possess or for any issue arising under the tribe's gaming compact in its current form or as it may be amended or replaced.

This waiver:

- i) shall terminate upon the tribe no longer having a state of Michigan liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises;
- ii) is granted solely to the state of Michigan in the state's furtherance of its obligations to regulate the state of Michigan liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises;
- iii) shall extend to inter alia, any judicial or non judicial action, including, but not limited to, any lawsuit, arbitration, and judicial or non judicial action to resolve disputes between the Tribe and the state of Michigan, and the assertion of any claim in a court of competent jurisdiction or with any arbitrator or arbitration panel to enforce the obligations under the Agreement;
- iv) shall be limited to Tribal assets; and
- v) shall be enforceable only in a court of competent jurisdiction, including courts of the State of Michigan, the Sault Chippewa Tribal Court and federal courts in Michigan (including the United States Bankruptcy Court) or any arbitrator or arbitration panel.
- vi) shall not extend to any third party.

Section 4 WAIVER OF TRIBAL COURT JURISDICTION

The Board of Directors waives the exclusive jurisdiction of the Tribal Court over any action arising under section 2.
