
WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has determined that it is in the best interests of the Tribe to rescind Resolution 2004-121 effective immediately.

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RESOLUTION TO BAN NON-MEMBER WILLIAM CROSS, JR. FROM THE SAULT STE. MARIE TRIBE OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TRIBAL LANDS

WHEREAS, the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians (the "Tribe") is organized pursuant to the Constitution of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has adopted the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indian's Tribal Code (the "Code") to codify laws and procedures as they may relate to the business and affairs of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VII, Section 1(h) of the Tribe's Constitution, the Board of Directors has the power to ban and remove from Tribal Lands any person not legally entitled to be on Tribal Lands; and

WHEREAS, such power to ban and remove individuals from Tribal Lands is codified in Chapter 61 of the Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 61.104(1) of the Code, the Tribe may ban or remove any real or artificial person for violations to the Code, any provision of Federal or State law, or the law, rule or ordinance of any corresponding local unit of government, that threatens the peace, health, safety, morals, general welfare or environmental quality of life of Tribal Lands including, but not limited to, violations of law committed by non-Indians which would be a violation of Tribal law if committed by an Indian on Tribal lands; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 61.104(5) of the Code, the Tribe may ban or remove any real or artificial person for doing, or threatening to do, any act upon Tribal Lands which seriously threatens the peace, health, safety, morals or general welfare of the Tribe, its members, or other persons living on Tribal Lands; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe finds that non-member William Cross, Jr. has engaged in conduct which seriously threaten the peace, health, safety, morals and general welfare of the Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, banning non-member William Cross, Jr. from Tribal Lands is necessary to protect the interests of the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors does hereby authorize the banning of non-member William Cross, Jr. from all Tribal lands.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors does hereby authorize any and all actions and documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the terms, conditions, and intent of this Resolution.
