NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Directors hereby approves the amendment to the Inland Consent Decree, Section XXV, to add the following language to the end of that paragraph:

For wolves, a species designated as a game species in Michigan in 2012, no harvest of wolves shall be permitted by the State or the Tribes unless the State and the Tribes agree that such harvest is appropriate and agree on an allocation of such harvest. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the removal, capture or use of lethal force against wolves, pursuant to Michigan law to protect livestock, other domestic animals, or human life shall be permitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors hereby authorizes the Chairperson, or his designees, to execute a stipulation for entry of the proposed consent decree, or other implementing documents as may be necessary.
